

Call for Incoming or Outgoing international doctoral mobility

The Neurograduate school is launching a call for applications for incoming or outgoing international mobility of **doctoral students**.

- The duration of the stay will be between **1 and 6 months** and the financial support will be **1000€/month**, for the whole duration of the stay
- Funding will be made available to the student and will not cover any lab expenses
- The stay must be completed before the end of 2024
- The call is endowed with a total of 15 months

Eligibility

1. (**incoming fellowships**) to be currently enrolled in a PhD program outside of France and be willing to join a team affiliated with the Neuroscience and Cognition (NSCo) doctoral program (see list of NSCo teams), or (**outgoing fellowships**) to be currently enrolled in the PhD program in Neuroscience and Cognition in Lyon and be willing to join a team outside France
2. to set up the research program to be carried out during the stay. This program must be proposed in agreement with the thesis supervisor and the person in charge of the implementation of the project in the host laboratory
3. Students who already obtained SFRI-NeuroG+ funding during their PhD are NOT eligible

Selection procedure

Selection criteria will include the assessment of :

- The academic and research curriculum of the applicant
- The research program. More specifically, the research program will have to be precise and consistent with the requested duration of the stay
- The added value of the stay to the student's training and to the progress of the thesis project
- The involvement of the applicant (specific objectives and tasks)

The selection committee will include :

- A representative of each laboratory affiliated with Neurograduate school (CRNL, ISC-MJ, SBRI, MeLiS; see <https://neurograduate.univ-lyon1.fr/partners/>)
- The head of the *Fellowships Action Team* of the Neurograduate school
- The director of the NSCo doctoral school
- A representative of the Lyon 1 University Neuroscience pedagogic team
- A representative of the NSCo PhDs students

Applications

Apply by sending **a single pdf document** named "LAST NAME_doctoral" at fellowships.neurograduate@univ-lyon1.fr including :

- The information form (use the template)
- CV (max. 2 pages)
- Research program including references list (10.000 characters incl. spaces)
- Letter from the PhD supervisor (home institution) confirming your enrolment in the PhD program
- Acceptance letter of the host laboratory

Application deadline: 31/10/2023

Results : 30/11/2023

Beginning - End of the stay : starting from 01/01/2024 - ending before 31/12/2024
