

## Call for Internship abroad scholarship – M1 students

The NeuroGraduate school is launching a call for applications for **outgoing** international mobility of master students registered in the **M1 Neurosciences path** of UCBL1.

- The duration of the stay will be **7 weeks** and the financial support will be **1000€/month**, for the whole duration of the stay (i.e. **1750 €** for each fellowship).
- The call is endowed with a maximum of **3 fellowships** for the academic year 2024-25

### Eligibility

1. Applicants should be currently enrolled in the M1 Neurosciences program in Lyon (UCBL) and be willing to join a team outside France. For foreign students, the laboratory should not be located in their home country.
2. Applicants should set up the research program to be carried out during the stay. This program must be proposed in agreement with the Head of the M1 Neurosciences program and the person in charge of the implementation of the project in the host laboratory.
3. Students who obtained a NeuroGraduate fellowship in previous years are eligible, but their candidature will be treated as low priority.

### Selection procedure

Applications will be evaluated based on three criteria (each rated on an ABC scale):

- **Academic excellence** (50%) : *e.g. grades and ranking.*
- **Experience** (30%) : *e.g. relevance and feasibility of the project, previous internships, added value for the student.*
- **Motivation** (20%) : *e.g. relevance of career plan, motivations for joining the research environment abroad.*

A score of C in any of the sections will be disqualifying. The other applicants will be ranked and the first 3 will be awarded the fellowship. Next will be assigned to a waiting list.

The selection committee will include :

- The head of *the Fellowships Action Team* of the NeuroGraduate school
- The director of the M1 Neurosciences

- The information form, that includes administrative information, the research program and the student's motivation statement (use the template)
- CV (max. 2 pages)
- Acceptance letter of the host laboratory
- Master director agreement
